

**SEMEN ORDERS**

Semen is available from the American Milking Devon Cattle Association. Pictures and pedigrees of available bulls can be viewed on the Association website at [www.milkingdevons.org](http://www.milkingdevons.org) . If you do not have a computer, your local public library may have one that is available to the public. A printed list can be obtained by writing or emailing the Registrar at the address below.

**Delivery of semen**

The cost of shipping is NOT included in the price of the semen. Contact North American Breeders Service (540-955-3647; [jeansch@crosslink.net](mailto:jeansch@crosslink.net) or [northamericanbreeders@verizon.net](mailto:northamericanbreeders@verizon.net) ) to arrange for payment of shipping costs (they will accept credit cards over the phone). Semen is shipped in a small liquid nitrogen canister, which must be returned to the shipper immediately.

**Long term storage of semen**

Semen must be stored in a liquid nitrogen tank. You must arrange for storage before your order is shipped to you. Your AI technician or veterinarian may be willing to store your semen. Individuals may also purchase their own tank, which must be recharged every 2-3 months. Your local AI technician should be able to give you further information about this option.
